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### Corrigendum

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## A revision of the Afrotropical hover fly genus *Afroxanthandrus* Kassebeer, 2000 (Diptera, Syrphidae), with the description of two new species and one new synonymy – Corrigendum

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The present corrigendum corrects figure numbers that were incorrect in Midgley *et al.* (2024).

**Page 63**, the key should read:

#### Key to species

1. Tergite 4 entirely dark. Yellow fascia on tergite 2 with curved or triangular posterior border (Figs 14, 16–17) ..... 2
- Tergite 4 with broad yellow fascia. Yellow fascia on tergite 2 with straight posterior border (Figs 13, 15) ..... 3
  
2. Tergite 3 with broad fascia, about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the length of the tergite (Figs 14, 16); scutal pile short, half as long or less as length of scape (Figs 8, 10); male genitalia: surstyli short, about 2.5 times as long as wide (Figs 20–21) ..... *A. congensis* (Curran, 1938)

- Tergite 3 with narrow fascia, about  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the length of the tergite (Fig. 17); scutal pile long, as long as or slightly longer than length of scape (Fig. 11) .....  
..... *A. longipilus* Kassebeer, 2000
- 3. Tergite 4 with broad fascia, similar in shape to fasciae on tergites 2 and 3 (Fig. 13); male genitalia: surstyli short, about twice as long as wide (Figs 18–19) ..... *A. comorosensis* sp. nov.
- Tergite 4 with narrow fascia, clearly narrower than fasciae on tergites 2 and 3 (Fig. 15); male genitalia: surstyli long, about eight times as long as wide (Figs 22–23) ..... *A. conopeum* sp. nov.

**Page 74**, in Remarks, 7<sup>th</sup> line: “...(Figs 19, 22)...” should read “...(Figs 20–21)...”.

**Page 76**, the figure legend should read: **Figs 18–23**. Male genitalia of species of *Afroxanthandrus* Kassebeer, 2000. **18–19**. *A. comorosensis* sp. nov., holotype (RMCA ENT 000056900). **18**. Dorsal view. **19**. Lateral view. **20–21**. *A. congensis* (Curran, 1938) (RMCA ENT 000028396). **20**. Dorsal view. **21**. Lateral view. **22–23**. *A. conopeum* sp. nov., paratype (NMSA-Dip 086809). **22**. Dorsal view. **23**. Lateral view. Scale bars = 0.5 mm.
