Corrigendum

Page 93, Fig. 6C:

The legend for Fig. 6C should be replaced, from: “*Th. viriabilis* sp. nov., paratype (slide no. YUS184, NKU)”.

To: “*Th. yingjingensis* sp. nov., paratype (slide no. YUS184, NKU)”.

The name *Thubana viriabilis* should, thus, be treated as unavailable (cf. Art. 13 in ICZN 1999).
